- Discussed having the event start later in the day, possibly early afternoon versus morning.
- Plan to reach out earlier (i.e, 8 weeks ahead) to local nurseries with an official letterhead to increase possible plant donations.
- This event, in the future, could become a possible partnership opportunity with Lepley & Company.

Annual Chalk the Walk Event

- This event will be on Saturday, June 3rd, at Duncan Plaza, from 10-1 pm.
- Tentative rain date will be the following Saturday, June 10th, at Duncan Plaza, from 10-1 pm. *Plan to communicate rain date on vender form and digital flyer.
- Working with the city to have the street blocked off during the event.
- Ben agreed to create a letterhead to pass along to local businesses, so that we
 can start the process of seeing who has a food truck (i.e., The Nook, Tremont,
 etc) or if they'd be willing to donate food (i..e, Kraus) and/or bottled water for the
 event. Look for an email with the letterhead in an upcoming email and respond if
 you're able to help with this process.
- Krackpot's agreed to bring their snow cone machine to this event.
- Artist Vender sign-up sheet for this event is on our website. Members agreed to the \$15 vender fee. Additional vender criteria TBD, i.e., 8x10 versus 10x10 space, tent, demon art, etc.
- Israel has offered to provide face painting at the event. Reach out to her if you're interested in helping her with this.
- Plan to have someone taking pictures on the ground and in the sky (i.e., drone) during event.

Impromptu Open Forum Discussion Re: MCAC Advertising/Marketing

- Creating a timeline for marketing MCAC events, i.e., 4 to 8 weeks prior to the event at minimum.
- Creating an event checklist to allow for better organization and delegation. Jenna volunteered to create a checklist template to be used for future events.
- Would like to have a digital flyer created for each event at least 8 weeks prior to the event.
- Discussed possibly getting WHS High School art students involved in creating flyers or event promotions.
- Encouraging MCAC members to create and share event posts on their social media.
- MCAC will post on Massillon Virtual Sounding Board, etc. Facebook pages
- Discussed having members share pictures/videos of events from the previous year to help promote events, specifically annual events like Chalk the Walk and Artoberfest.
- Need Chalk the Walk and Artoberfest digital flyers ASAP.
