Chalk the Walk - Review

- Number of venders: 7 (i.e., compared to zero the previous year)
- Donations via cash/venmo: \$95.00
- Number of people present: guesstimate of 50-100 people
- How can we improve upon this annual event?
 - Aim for a date in mid-June to avoid dance recitals.
 - Establish an earlier marketing campaign (i.e., start in April at the latest).
 Passing out flyers to local YMCA and Massillon Boys & Girls Club. Create yard/street signage, especially near downtown. Gorilla marketing on social media.
 - Drum event incorporation led by Eric.
 - Offer contests among local artists to encourage increased artist participation at this event.
 - Incorporate raffle baskets donated by local businesses. Could also do a 50/50 to increase MCAC donations.
 - Venders stated that they enjoyed that we had free food at the event (i.e., donuts, pizza).

Massillon Artoberfest

- Massillon Artoberfest will be Saturday, October 7th, 2023 at Paradigm from noon to 5pm.
- The name was adjusted to "Massillon Artoberfest" to be more inclusive to other participating Massillon businesses.
- We're collaborating with Sangria Stand since they had a similar event in previous years. Specific information re: collaboration TBD.
- Paradigm is currently lining up musicians to play during the event.
- Brainstormed ways to involve other businesses that would be interested in collaborating with us including Benders, Erie Street Vinyl, Wolf Games and Models, KrackPots, Lepley, etc. (i.e., create a map, passport system using QR codes, Art Hop).
- Discussed having fall themed activities at event including pumpkin painting. Will need to reach out for pumpkin donations.
- Need flyers for this event ASAP. Would like to have digital as well paper/signage.
 Would like to organize virtual gorilla marketing for this event. Telegram channel to increase member engagement.
