Arts in Stark: Started County 60 years ago by the Timken family. Wanted symbolic center for the community. Created a non profit and gifted it to canton cultural center for the arts. Resident arts groups, events. Arts in Stark owns all the land. Core focus is cultural center - you need to be more. funding/ grant making. Community based raising funds. Arts build: 7 major arts groups in the county. Provided opporting grants. Arts impacts (non profits, etc) grants can go up to \$7500. Only saw 2 applications from massillon. How can they help support? They manage a bucket of money through bed tax (hotel) money gets put into a pull of money and money goes out towards grants \$400,000-\$500,000. Helps Major events.
